Staff Sergeant (SSG) Ashley Buhl 2023 Drill Sergeant of the Year (Active Component)

SSG Ashley Nicole Buhl was born in Richmond, VA, and raised in Crestview, FL. After graduating from Crestview High School in 2011, she attended college at Troy University, where in 2015, she earned a Bachelor's degree in Marine Biology. In February 2016, SSG Buhl enlisted in the U.S. States Army and completed basic training at Fort Sill, OK, where she graduated in the top 10% of her battery. Subsequently, she went to Fort Sam Houston, TX, to earn the



Military Occupation Specialty 68W - Health Care Specialist. In doing so, she was awarded the Junior Leader of the Cycle Award.

SSG Buhl has served in multiple duty positions ranging from a Line Medic to a Treatment Noncommissioned Officer (NCO), and even a Medical Operations NCO, while assigned to the 1st Battalion, 14th Field Artillery Regiment, Fort Sill, OK. While stationed at Fort Sill, SSG Buhl deployed twice in support of Operation Inherent Resolve, Operation Spartan Shield, and Operation Freedom's Sentinel in the countries of Iraq, the United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, and Afghanistan.

After four days of physically and mentally grueling competition, SSG Buhl was announced as the U.S. Army Drill Sergeant of the Year (Active Duty Component) on 15 September 2023.
