Colonel Corcoran serves as the Chief of Staff for the U.S. Army Center for Initial Military Training (USACIMT) which is responsible for annually transforming 130,000 civilian volunteers into Soldiers who are disciplined, fit, grounded in Army Values, and combat ready. His previous assignment was as the Executive Officer for the Assistant Chief of Army Reserve in the Pentagon.
