

Colonel Kenneth M. Dwyer Brigade Commander, Leader Training Brigade

Colonel (COL) Kenneth M. Dwyer, a native of Easley, SC, graduated from Furman University with a Bachelor's degree in Health and Exercise Science in 1998 and received his commission into the U.S. Army as an Infantry Officer.

COL Dwyer's first assignment was with 2nd Battalion, 187th Infantry Regiment, 101st Airborne as a Rifle Platoon Leader. After serving with the Infantry for five years, he was selected and trained to be an Army Special Forces Officer at Fort Bragg, NC.
