Major General Laurence “Scott” Linton assumed duties as the Deputy Commanding General-USAR, United States Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC), on Aug 27, 2022, and Deputy Commanding General, Center for Initial Military Training (CIMT), on August 16, 2024. Prior to his current assignments, he served as the TRADOC Deputy Chief of Staff.

MG Linton enlisted in the Army in 1985 and served in the 218th MP Company in Garmisch, Germany. While in college, he enlisted in the United States Army Reserve serving as a Non-Commissioned Officer instructing Basic Rifle Marksmanship in the 108th Training Command. MG Linton graduated in 1992 from the State University of New York at Cortland and commissioned as an Armor Officer.
